December 6: Wreaths Across America: You might have heard of it; Wreath [260,000+] are assembled in Maine and placed on all US military graves in Arlington Cemetery / Gettysburg and all US Military Cemetery’s in the US and overseas.

The mission of “*Wreaths Across America*” is to honor the fallen from all branches of our nation’s armed forces in cemetery’s across the nation. Thousands of volunteers will participate in that mission by laying the convoy’s wreaths on graves thought the country and at Arlington National Cemetery on Saturday December 12, 2015 Least we should forget them, God Bless!

On its journey to Arlington, the convoy is escorted by the Patriot Guard Riders, a motorcycle and motor group of over 65,000 strong, and by state and municipal law enforcement. Rallies are held along the route at schools, veteran’s homes and civic locations with the participation of many groups, volunteers, and organizations including:

The American Gold Star others, Civic Air Patrol, Sons and Daughters of the American Revolution, The American Legion, and Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Please plan on attending and offering your support next year; the Honor Guard members from our Assembly and from throughout the State will be posting & retrieving the colors, please keep this honored event in mind.
